

The Central Ohio Aviation community lost a great AMT this past weekend. Terry Joseph Huff, 56, passed away on January 20, 2019 after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Terry graduated from the Columbus Technical Institute Aviation Maintenance Technology program in September of 1983. After graduation, he began his career as an aviation mechanic with Clydesdale Aircraft. In 1993, he continued his career with PDQ Air Service, which later became Airnet II. In June of 1999, he began adjunct teaching in the evening Columbus State Community College AMT program and continued teaching until August of 2018.

Terry had many interests outside of aviation, including scuba diving, which he enjoyed immensely. He is survived by his wife, Josie. Terry will be deeply missed by friends and colleagues.
